
STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

KEY ISSUES

North Carolina's student population is increasingly diverse and growing, leaving policymakers and school administrators with the challenge of meeting a new variety of unique needs in every classroom.

POPULATION GROWTH IN NORTH CAROLINA

North Carolina is one of the nation's fastest-growing states, ranking 9th in population in 2017 with an estimated 10,273,419 residents.¹ Between 2000 and 2010, North Carolina ranked 6th in population growth with a population increase of 18.5%, which was almost double the national rate of 9.7%.² Between 2010 and 2017 North Carolina's population grew at a rate of 7.7% compared to a national rate of 5.5%.³

North Carolina is projected to gain approximately one million residents in each decade through 2040; however, population growth is not distributed consistently across all counties. Urban areas such as Raleigh and Charlotte have experienced significantly more growth since 2000 and are the main causes of the state's population growth. Seven counties concentrated in the northeast and central coast portions of the state decreased in population from 2000 to 2010, and thirty-eight counties are projected to lose population between 2010 and 2020.⁴

In North Carolina, the number of children in public schools is tracked by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NC DPI) as Average Daily Membership, often referred to as ADM.

The total ADM in 2016-17 for North Carolina's 115 LEAS was 1,428,051 compared to 1,389,305 in 2006-07.

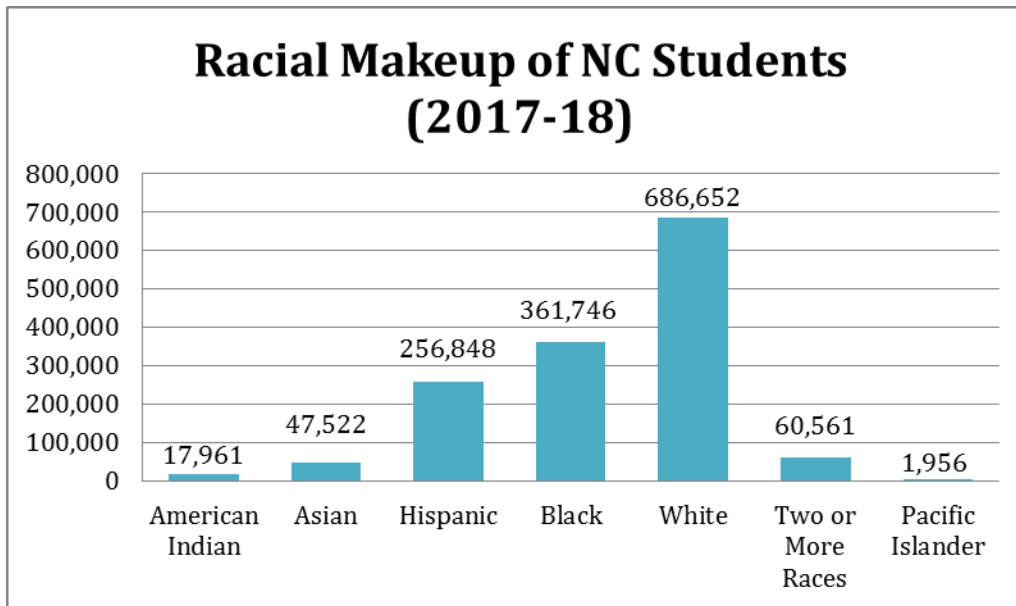

RACIAL MAKEUP OF NORTH CAROLINA STUDENT POPULATION

North Carolina's student population is becoming increasingly diverse. In the 2017-18 school year, 1.3% of traditional public school students were American Indian, 3.3% were Asian, 17.9% were Hispanic, 25.2% were black, 47.9% were white, 4.2% were two or more races, and 0.1% were Pacific Islander.⁵ These percentages do not include charter schools (see below for racial makeup of charter schools).

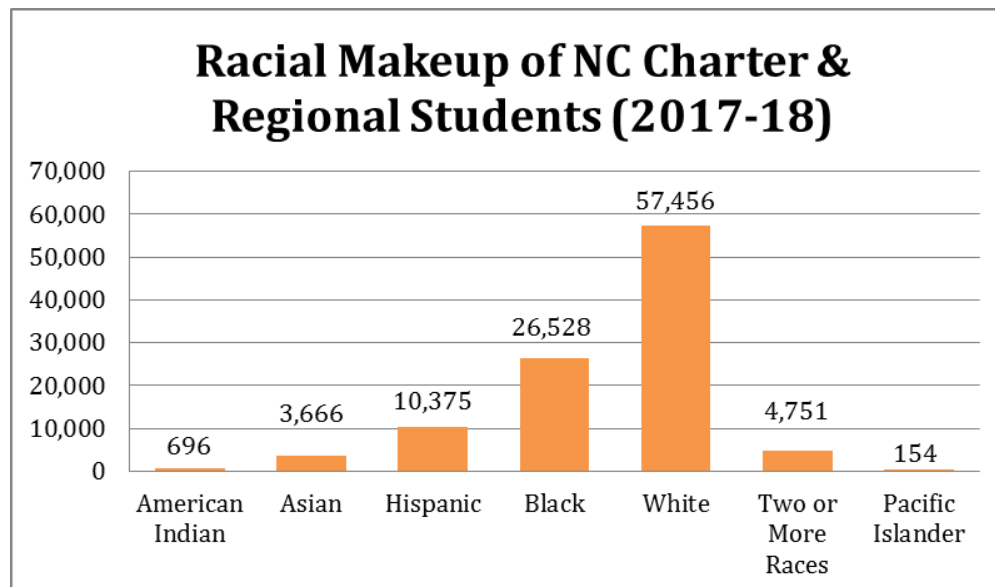
